For 97 years the LWV has been at work to improve our government and engage all citizens in the decisions that impact their lives.

The League of Women Voters of the United States was founded in 1920, emerging from the National American Women Suffrage Association. The League is rooted in the movement that secured women's right to vote. Men have been members since 1974.

LWV operates at national, state and local levels through more than 800 state and local Leagues, in all 50 states, as well as in DC, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and Hong Kong. The League is one of America's most trusted grassroots organizations.

The League of Women Voters of Portland (LWVPDX) was organized in 1926. *Membership* in the LWV is open to all persons who are at least 16 years of age. A membership form is available under JOIN on lwvpx.org or by calling 503-228-1675.

The League is nonpartisan, which means that, as an organization, it does not support or oppose political parties or candidates for elective office. However, after detailed research, study, and consensus/agreement, League members may **adopt "positions."** Using these positions, the League may advocate to influence public policy. That is why you may see that LWV Oregon or LWV Portland supports a state or local ballot measure in some elections.

As individuals, League members are encouraged to engage fully in the political process.

Register to Vote

•**Online** at the Oregon Secretary of State's Office:

•**In Person** at Multnomah County Board of Elections, 1040 SE Morrison St., Portland, OR 97214, 503-988-3720, mcelections.org. Or at any Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles office.

•**By Mail** - Print registration forms are available at all branches of the Multnomah County Public Library and at U.S. Post Offices, and can be printed online from mcelections.org. Complete and sign the form and mail to the address indicated on the form.

•**By Oregon Motor Voter** – You are automatically registered when you obtain a driver's license or Oregon I.D. at the Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles. You will be registered with no party affiliation.

Qualifications to Register to Vote:

- A resident of Oregon
- A United States Citizen
- At least 17 years of age

Last day to register to vote in any particular election is 21 days before election day. There are four scheduled election dates each year in Oregon: the 2nd Tuesday in March; the 3rd Tuesday in May; the 3rd Tuesday in September; and the 1st Tuesday after the first Monday in November. Other special elections can be held in March, September or November.

Voter information - To update your registration (name, address, party), learn about vote by mail in Oregon, absentee ballots, election history, campaign finance, current elected officials and much more, contact the Oregon Elections Division, sos.oregon.gov/voting-elections, 503-986-1518.

Voting in the Oregon May primary. Each major political party uses the election to nominate their candidates for the November general election. Major parties have the option of choosing a "closed system," meaning only registered voters in that party can vote for that party's candidates. Or, a major party can choose an "open system," where the major party allows voters who are not registered with any party to vote for their candidates. In addition, there are usually nonpartisan candidates on the primary ballot that you may vote for whatever your party affiliation. So you may always vote in the primary, but you must belong to a major political party to vote for partisan candidates if all major parties declare the election "closed."
